What do the class representatives do?




My role as a class representative is quite divided and takes place in different arenas. Here are three points with some of the tasks I work with throughout the year:

- 1 I represent the class in meetings with USN, which means that I am dependent on the opinions of my fellow students in various matters.
- 2 I collaborate with several people such as: lecturers, course supervisors, study advisor and other student representatives for a better study day academically and socially.
- 3 Specifically, in SDSN I am the class's voice in student council meetings. Here I am together with the other class representatives in my faculty, we raise matters for discussion and information - this is to see if others in the faculty have the same problems as my class.

How much time does the work require?




As mentioned on the previous slide, you have **2 fixed meeting points per month**. You are obliged to attend these.

One Wednesday a month (during democracy time, from 2.15 p.m.), or another suitable time, you are responsible for carrying out the class meeting. Here you will receive and/or give input and issues to/from fellow students.

On the first Wednesday of the month, you are expected to meet in the student council. (described previous slide)



It varies a lot, but as a rule it is not particularly time-consuming - there is no problem with having the position alongside your studies and possibly a job.
